

POTTERY VACCINATION AND MASKING POLICY (January 1, 2022)

Fully-Vaccinated Pottery

- All Glen Echo Pottery students (adults and teens), instructors and weekly contractors must be **fully vaccinated** against Covid-19 in order to enter our facilities.
- **“Fully vaccinated” includes the initial Covid vaccine series (Moderna, Pfizer, or J&J) plus a booster shot if eligible.** Current students who are eligible for but do not already have their booster shot will be required to get it as soon as possible and show proof by February 21, 2022 at the latest.
- Our “fully-vaccinated” requirement will remain in effect until further notice.
- New students who enroll in our classes will be contacted with further instructions on how to document your vaccine status with the Pottery administration.

Masking

- Well-fitted face masks that effectively block respiratory particle transfer must be worn indoors at all times. Approved masks: N95, KN95, KF95 or surgical mask covered with a tightly-fitting cloth mask.
- No single surgical or cloth masks allowed.

Modifications and Updates

The Pottery may modify this vaccination and masking policy for reasons including updates in CDC guidance or recommendations, or due to other changes in circumstances.
